The NORWESCAP Career and Life Transitions Center for Women which provides supportive services to meet the needs of "Displaced Homemakers" in Hunterdon, Mercer, Somerset and Warren Counties. A "Displaced Homemaker" is a person who has lost their primary means of financial support due to: Separation, Divorce, Widowhood, or Disability of Spouse. The Career and Life Transitions Center for Women focuses on providing quality services that will assist women to gain personal and economic self-sufficiency and reach their full potential through education, training, job readiness, community referrals and supportive services.

The NORWESCAP Fatherhood Program- 24/7 Dad which is a collaboration between NORWESCAP's Supporting Youth in Their Communities Program, Family Success Center, and Head Start. This initiative focuses on providing an effective, strengths based, nationally accredited curriculum to a diverse group of fathers, male role models, and male caregivers. The group meets on a weekly basis to discuss issues specific to men and fatherhood. The discussions center on appropriate discipline, communication, work and life balance, manhood, and many more topics.
